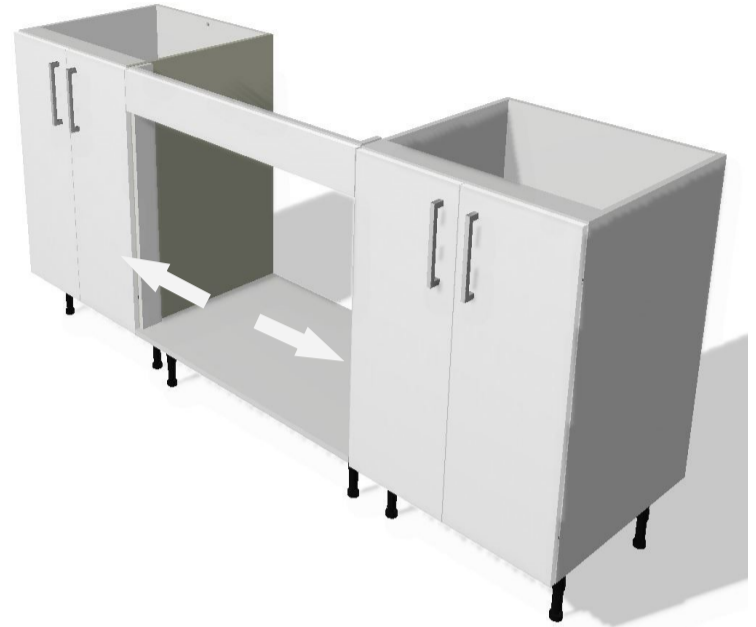


- 1 Different Construction style:** the Under Bench Oven is essentially a base for the oven to sit on, with two mullions sitting vertically. The Mullions help to pack the Oven centrally and allow a decorative rail to be fitted to top.

This decorative rail allows for different size ovens to be inserted and by trimming the rail you can ensure a neat filler piece results...



- 2 Part of a Team:** the Under Bench Oven has open sides and needs to be installed adjacent with other cabinets. You can see here that the two mullions are screwed into adjacent cabinets in order to finish the installation...



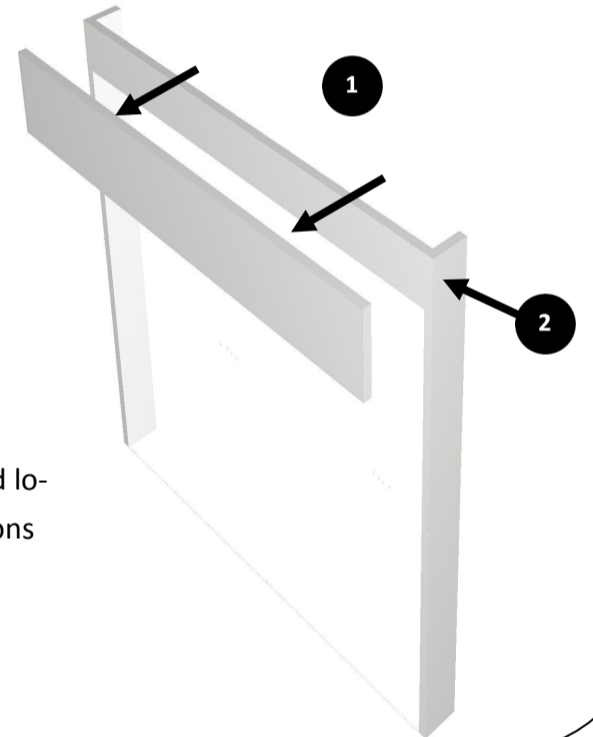
- 3 Identify the bottom:** insert your plastic feet into the bottom of the unit and then you can place into its position ready for the mullions to be inserted..



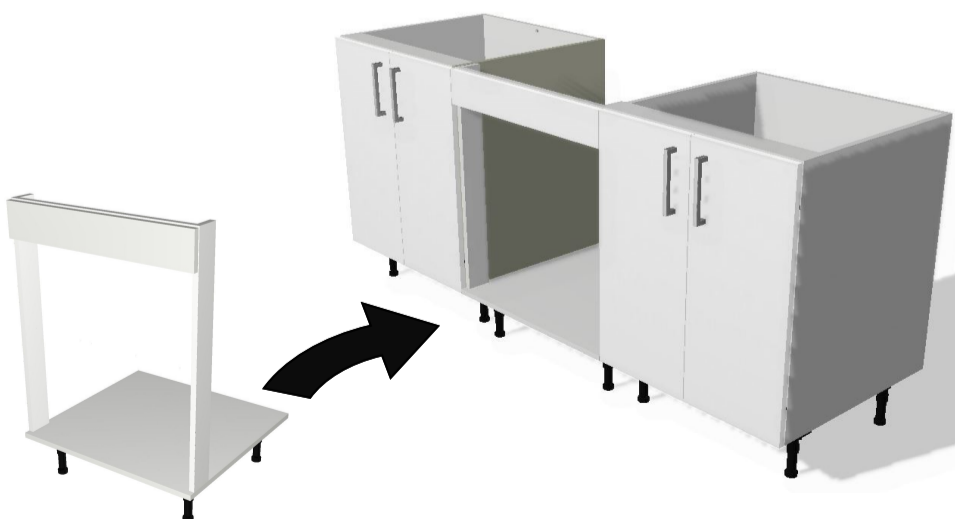
- 4 Assemble the Frame.** Place the rails flat onto the ground and line up at the top.


**(1)** Screw the white rail into the coloured front ensuring they are flush at the top - look for the screw holes from the rear.

**(2)** Then insert dowels and locate and screw both mullions onto the rail.



- 5 Locate the Base:** insert the base position into its final position. Now place the mullions with fixed rail on top and screw off into the adjacent cabinets on each side.



 You may need to level your base off using your plastic feet.

- 6 You can insert your appliance:** ..... Always use a licensed electrician to connect and make safe your electrical appliances...
